Public Participation:

Justin presented a complete and thorough report to the Township on the full depth reclamation, which MKA is proposing for the temporary stabilization and permanent stabilization of DRR. Justin reported that it was felt that DEP is on board with what is being proposed.

Jim Mitcheltree promised Justin a Township letter of approval/disapproval on the black top portion of the proposal.

Township Reports:

Road Master Report:

The current Liquid Fuels Budget spread sheet and labor time sheets for each employee were reviewed and found to be in order by the Supervisors.

Rick reported the gas companies bought the Township 22 loads of DSA stone and Barry Garverick from PennDot Municipalities Services toured the Township streets and Barry suggested the Township start thinking about applying another 1 ½ inch of black top on the streets.

Other Business:

There was a short discussion on the subject of a Fire Insurance Escro Ordinance.

Mike Yohe questioned the Township if anything could be done about truck jake brakes on Route 44 in the area on Ramsey Village. A short discussion followed.

Correspondence was gone over and acted on accordingly.
