

*Cummings Township Supervisors
Regular Meeting Minutes
August 9, 2011*

The regular monthly meeting of the Cummings Township Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Jim Mitchertree at 7:00 PM with Supervisors Walt Braddock, Joyce Raesner and Jim Mitcheltree present. Road Master Richard Bierly and Secretary/Treasurer Will Wolfe were also in attendance.

Attendance from the public was as follows: Kathleen Bowlan & John Gasperin

Motion was made by Joyce Raesner and seconded by Walt Braddock approving the Minutes of July 2, 2011. MCU

Public Participation:

There was no public participation.

Joyce Raesner mentioned that it had been rumored there were 3 or 4 trailers on Third Street going to be removed from the Township. She also asked the Zoning Officer to "check it out" because before a trailer is removed from the Township or dismantled a requirement of proof of taxes paid in full is required.

Township Reports:

The following is the Municipal Zoning Permit Officer's (M.P.O.) report for the prior month.

Eleven (11) Zoning Permits were issued since the last meeting as follows:

- (1) to Neil Wolfe for a 12 x 24 storage shed.*
- (1) to Robert Wingrove for a cabin major remodel*
- (9) to Anadarko E & P Co. for well pads w/ up to 6 wells each.*

No known violations was reported by Will.

Road Master Report:

The current Liquid Fuels Budget spread sheets for each employee were reviewed and found to be in order by the Supervisors.

The Road Master reported HRI has completed the job at Ramsey Rd intersection on DRR by putting in a new pipe, stone and a box culvert. HRI also spread and graded about 13 loads of stone on DRR from the intersection almost to the curve.

A discussion followed concerning the condition of the Waterville side of DRR.

Rick Bierly questioned the Supervisors concerning spending General Fund monies on mowing and weedwacking, especially at the fire hall. It was felt by the Supervisors the expenditure was minimal and continue to mow and weedwack.

Other Business:

The Wayne Township Landfill Residential Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event was announced and briefly discussed.

Concerning the Hurting property (Point House), Chairman Jim Mitcheltree reported the Township Solicitor has sent Brant a registered letter instructing him to remove the rocks and any signage that tends to restrict the use of the public R-O-W, by July 31, 2011, and if this doesn't happen a law suit will be filed against him.

Winter time snow plowing concerning Church Street, Hartung property and the Bernhardt property were briefly discussed.

Jim reported the rocks have been removed but not the No Trespassing sign.

The Recreation Advisory Board meeting, the Recreation Advisory Board responsibilities, and the Recreation Grant status was discussed at length.

The Treasurer was instructed by Chair Jim Mitcheltree to transfer \$ 8500.00 from the Capitol Reserve to the Recreation Fund in order to pay the Soft Tile invoice of \$ 8500.00.

The road paving bid wording from PennDot's Barry Garverick and turned over to Jim Mitcheltree. Jim volunteered to contact the three gas companies to see if they will share the cost.

Motion was made by Jim Mitcheltree and seconded by Joyce Raesner approving the Treasurer's Report and payment of all outstanding bills. MCU

Correspondence was gone over and acted on accordingly.
